Who are we?

We are a charity based in Bath that offers information, guidance and counselling to any child or young person aged 10 - 25 living, working or studying in Bath & North East Somerset.

Our services are free, confidential and independent. We offer practical and emotional support and a safe place to talk about any issue big or small.

You talk. We listen. How we can help you:

You can contact us directly by phone, text, email or by calling into Off the Record in Bath. Our friendly and experienced staff are here to listen, advise and support or answer any questions you may have.

We help with a range of problems from exam stress, anxiety and depression to worries about sexuality, relationships and family breakdown. We can also help if you have experienced bullying, abuse or are self-harming or feeling suicidal.

Whatever your problem, we promise to listen.

Do you need someone to talk to?

If you are worried about something and want to talk to someone, our Counselling and Listening Support Service will be able to help.

Our workers are trained to listen and provide you with information, advice and support. If needed, you can access our counselling service to help you understand your thoughts and feelings.

Are you LGBTQ and looking for support?

If you are aged 13-21 and Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender or questioning your sexuality / gender identity, then come along and join our weekly youth group called SPACE.

This is an open and friendly space to meet other LGBTQ young people and get support around issues such as positive self-identity, homophobic, biphobic or transphobic bullying and safe sex.

You can also access one to one support if you need to talk.

Do you want to have your say about what happens to you in your life?

Our Shout Out! Advocacy Service is here to support you if you feel you are not being listened to or need help to get your voice heard. One of our Advocacy Workers will listen to you, help you to understand your rights and ensure you have a say in the decisions affecting you. This may include attending a meeting with you or helping you to write a letter.

You can access this service if you are: in care, leaving care, subject to a child protection conference, a young person with a disability or are aged 16/17 and are homeless.

Parents, carers and professionals, if you are worried about a young person, please contact Off the Record to speak with our team, or you can find out more information and download a referral form from our website.

Do you want your voice heard?

If you want to get involved and help improve services for children and young people, Off the Record can provide you with a range of opportunities; this can be designing, improving or influencing services which you might have used or would like to use.

You can join groups like The Youth Forum, and the In Care Council.
